New Global Grant Scholar Begins Journey

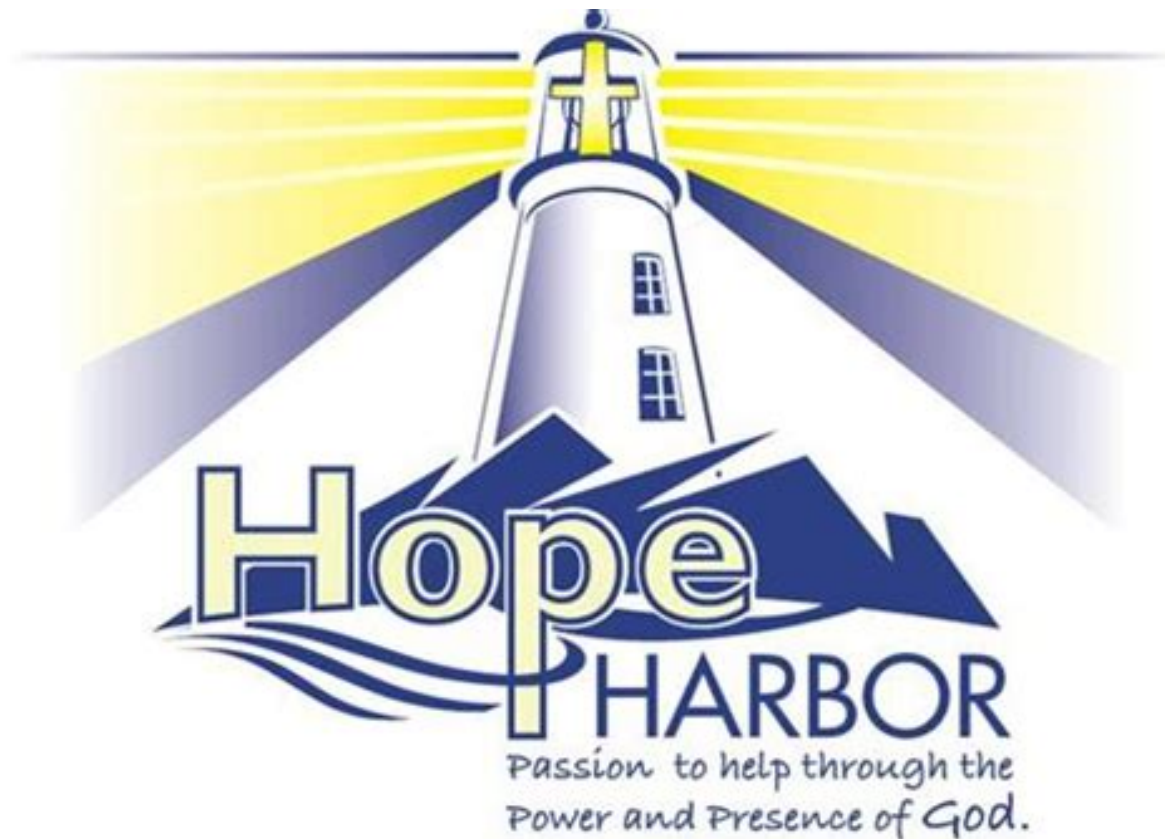
