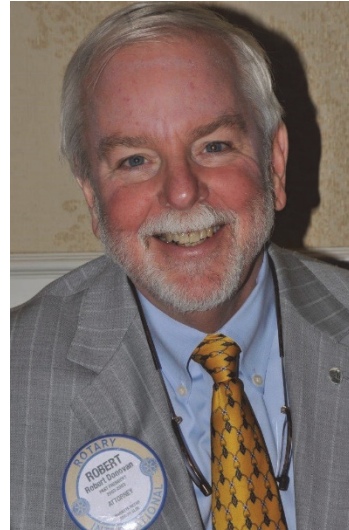

Amy Erskine gave sunshine for her son John's 21st birthday.



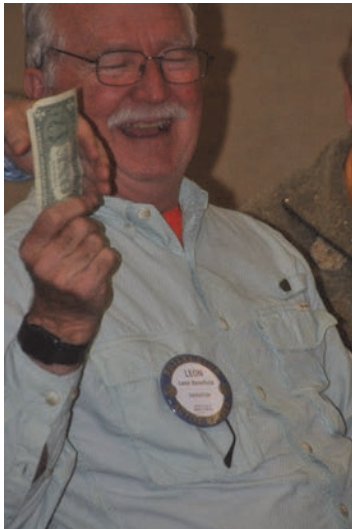
Marc Kornfield gave sunshine for his first tennis tournament after surgery – he won!
