## THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM Congressman Drew Ferguson

The Honorable Drew Ferguson (U.S. Congress, Georgia's Third District) spoke to the Rotary Club of Griffin about his first year in Congress. He began by saying that Griffin and his life had changed in the last year as he began his service in Congress. He stated that Griffin now had the College and Career Academy which, a year ago was just being discussed. His added that a year ago he was seeking the election to the 3<sup>rd</sup> District Congressional seat, and now he serves in that seat. The freshman Congressman said that he has found there are a lot of fine and good men and women in Congress who represent their respective districts. But, he noted that regional differences make it difficult to pass legislation and, unfortunately, there is a growing division between rural America and urban America. While both segments require legislative attention, those in rural America face major problems which must be addressed. Even with this divisiveness, Congress has passed over 500 legislative bills this past year, with the majority being bipartisan. Legislation important to the Third District includes the Perkins Career and Technical Education bill which affects technical colleges. Ferguson said that it has support from both parties and deals with the union of high schools and technical colleges. The Congressman feels that the first phase of the proposed infrastructure program will positively impact aviation, including the new regional airport for Griffin and Spalding County. This legislation has passed from committee with only 13 descending votes. The nation's economic growth is the highest in the last 15 years, which the Congressman attributes to tax reform and regulatory relief. He noted that one of the biggest problems facing America with this growth is the source of the work force. There must be a realignment of education in the U.S. to address those needs so that we help match people with their skills, talents and interests. He added that the 2018 Farm Bill will have reforms to the SNAP program and the food stamp program. that such programs as Social Security and Medicare must undergo reform. The Congressman closed by thanking people in the community for offering their thoughts and ideas to him.
