Mary Chatman, PhD, RN joined WellStar Health System in March 2017 as Vice President and Chief Operating Officer for Kennestone Regional Medical Center. In September of 2017 she was appointed Interim President for Kennestone while still maintaining her Chief Operating Officer duties. In March 2018 she was appointed Senior Vice President and President of WellStar Kennestone. In December 2018 Mary assumed responsibility for a second WellStar Health System Hospital – Windy Hill.

In this role, she oversees all aspects of operations for two hospitals, three Health Parks, and 46 outpatient departments, working with the Senior Team which includes

VP’s for Finance, Human Resources, Nursing, Operations, and Medical Staff. She is responsible for collaboratively developing the vision and implementing the strategic direction in concert with hospital and system level leadership.

Prior to joining WellStar, Mary served as Chief Operating Officer/Chief Nursing Officer at Memorial University Health System in Savannah Georgia for 8 years. During this time, she was responsible for day to day operations of the 654-bed hospital as well as nursing operations. In addition, she served as Interim Chief Information Officer for Memorial and led the \$85M electronic health record conversion from McKesson to EPIC.

Mary attended college in eastern North Carolina where she earned three nursing degrees: to include a PhD. She has served on local, state, and national boards including being appointed by Governor Deal to serve on the Board of Nursing in 2011, where she served 2 years, one as vice chair. Since she has been at WellStar, she has been embraced by the community. She has been recognized as a 2018 Women of Excellence recipient in Atlanta, received a Nursing Achievement Award, recognized nationally by the MBA Diversity Magazine as a ‘Top 50 under 50’ and most recently, recognized as a Fellow in the Malcom Baldrige Program.

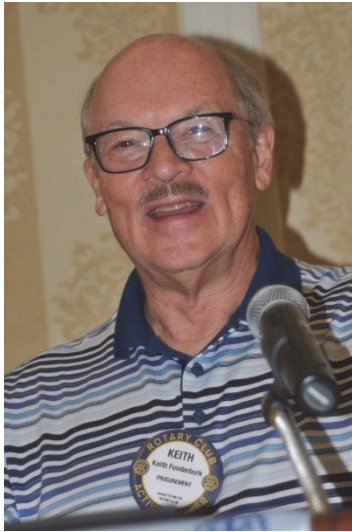

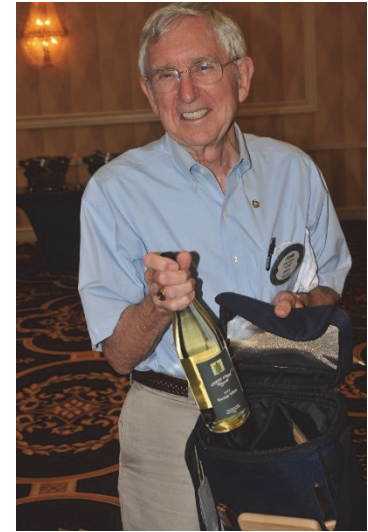

Josh Wilkins conducted the invocation, led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test and gave a Meet Your Rotarian talk.



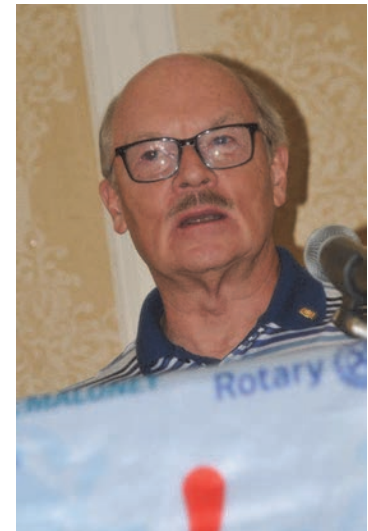
Past President John Elliott won a bottle of wine and a wine tote in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.

President Keith Funderburk gave sunshine for his mother in-law's recent 90th birthday party



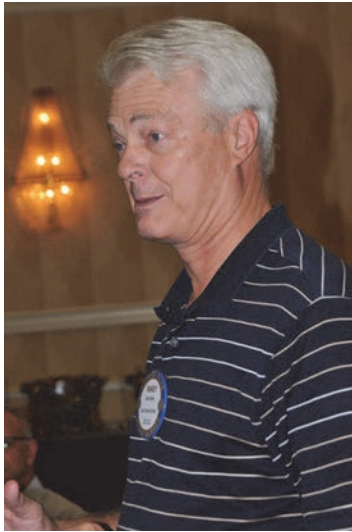
Past President Bob Harper gave sunshine for a recent trip to Alaska with his wife **Judy**.



Buck Buchanan gave sunshine for the release of his second book, "*The Game of Sales*".



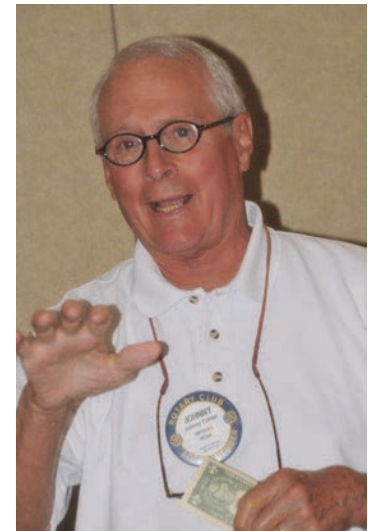

Johnny Fulmer gave sunshine for an antique car show coming to the Marietta Farmer's Market.



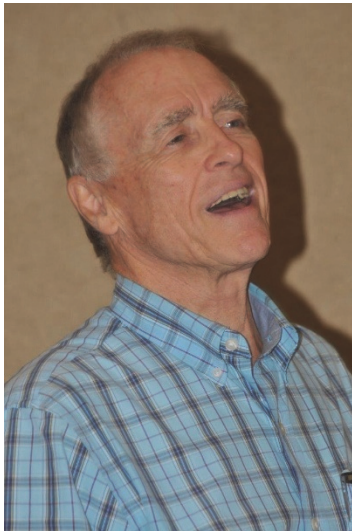

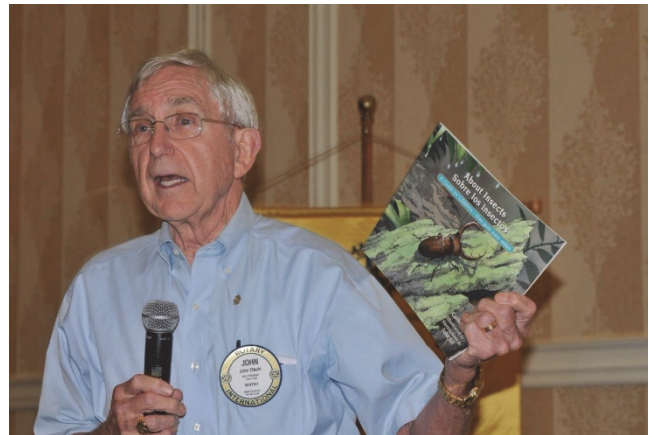
Jim Mosman received his blue mebership badge.
