Roy served in 2009-2010 as District Governor of Rotary International District 6900. It was a year of superlative accomplishment for the district. District 6900 delivered more service with more projects and more grants than any other Rotary district in the world - and this in a year with no financial match from The Rotary Foundation.

Prior to 2009-2010, Roy served multiple terms as District Paul Harris Society Chair. In that tenure, the District's Paul Harris Society grew to be the largest Paul Harris Society in the world.
